



FIMBC General Rules and Policies

1. Motorized vehicles, bicycles, and skating are not permitted in the Shelter House.
2. There is NO roughhousing, swimming, skiing, fireworks, running, fishing, or loitering on the docks or dock area.
3. Dock spaces are for Renters only. If guests need an overnight boat slip, they should contact the Riverfront Chair or the Caretaker.
4. The Courtesy Dock is for passenger loading and unloading. Please do not tie off your boat and leave.
5. Children under the age of 12 must wear a Coast Guard-approved life jacket while walking on the Boat Club docks.
6. Boaters will observe the NO WAKE ZONE by running at IDLE SPEED ONLY at all times in designated areas.
7. There is no hanging out, loud music, revving motors, or group gatherings after 10 p.m. in the Boat Club parking lot. Boat Club members may congregate in the lot, keeping noise minimal.
8. Parking only as signs designate.
9. There is no rutting or donuts in the Boat Club parking lot with motorized vehicles.
10. Any unauthorized or abandoned vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.
11. Children under 12 must be accompanied or supervised by their parents or appointed adult guardians while they play or swim on Boat Club property. Children will follow the Indiana state laws for operating motor vehicles.
12. Trash dumpsters are for river-generated trash by campers or Members. Oversized items or trash from people's homes are not allowed. Violators will be fined.
13. No firearms may be discharged on Boat Club Property.
14. Guests will use other members' campground lots for recreation, parking, etc, if the lot renter grants permission. Boat Club property is available for recreational activities to members and their guests.
15. All ramping shall be done in an orderly manner and by turn only.
16. All guests and nonmembers ramping boats are subject to current ramp fees.
17. All animals should be leashed on club property and are not allowed in the Shelter House when food is present.

18. There is no smoking during Boat Club events inside the Shelter. There are designated places to dispose of your cigarette butts; do not throw them on the ground.
